Navigate	Share	Anchor
Research your chosen topic. This could include looking in books, online or visiting places (museums, libraries etc.)	Create a piece of writing about what you have found out. This could be typed or hand written. Tell us about your amazing discoveries.	Create a project to show off everything you have learned. This could be a model, picture, video podcast ... let your imagination go wild!

Scenario: You are part of a tribe who have arrived at an uninhabited island. You are going to set up a new civilisation here. You will need shelter, food, water, transportation and power.

Navigate: Choose part of the scenario to research- which part is up to you. Pick something that interests you. (Examples include how electricity could be generated, transportation methods to get to the island, ways of growing food, how to build a shelter). You can choose one or more- it's up to you.

Share: Complete a written piece- this could be a plan of what you would do if you were the leader of the tribe. It could be a summary of your research or it could be a story told from the point of view of one of the residents within the tribe.

Anchor: Now create a project piece to sum up what you have learned. You could create a model of your island or a working electrical circuit (hint you can use lemons as batteries). You could create a brochure to advertise your island. The choices are endless.

Your finished project needs to be submitted on Friday 9 September 2016. It should be handed in to your tutor.
