Navigate	Share	Anchor
Research your chosen topic. This could include looking in books, online or visiting places (museums, libraries etc.)	Create a piece of writing about what you have found out. This could be typed or hand written. Tell us about your amazing discoveries.	Create a project to show off everything you have learned. This could be a model, picture, video podcast ... let your imagination go wild!

Scenario: Each year, millions of tons of recyclable materials are sent to landfill. You have been asked to design a product which could re-use something which would normally be thrown away. This could reuse all of the item or part of it, or even several parts. (E.g. all of a water bottle, part of a cup or three ice cream tubs). Let your imagination go.

Navigate: Choose part of the scenario to research- which part is up to you. Pick something that interests you. (How to make a terrarium from a bottle, how to make jewellery from plastic bags, 20 uses for a paper clip). You can choose one or more- it's up to you.

Share: Complete a written piece- this could be a plan of what you would do to reduce the amount people throw away. It could be a summary of your research or it could be a story told from the point of view of someone living 100 years from now- What would it be like if we keep throwing materials away?

Anchor: Now create a project piece to sum up what you have learned. You could create a model of your product or a new type of recycling bin. You could create a brochure to advertise your recycling initiative or a web page to show people how to re-use unwanted materials.

Your finished project needs to be submitted on Friday 9 September 2016. It should be handed in to your tutor.
